



PREFACE

This bulletin is produced by the Statistics Department on monthly migration statistics of the Kingdom for the month of May 2017. It shows the international arrivals and departures by months back to January 2013, mode of transportation, type of passengers, purpose of visit, age group of passengers and some charts for analysis purposes.

The data is extracted from the arrival and departure cards of the Immigration Department, Ministry of Foreign Affairs, and Customs Department's vessel & yacht log book.

This bulletin also presents information relating to gender of passengers and country of usual residence, and country visited.

Special thanks are extended to the Immigration Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade, Customs Department of the Ministry of Revenue Services, Airport Terminal Services, Tonga Airport Limited and Ports Authority for their assistance in providing their administrative information relating to these statistics. I am also grateful particularly to my staff members who contributed to the compilation of this report.

Any suggestions that recipients of this bulletin wish to make for its future improvement will be welcome by the Statistics Department.





- An increase of 46.6% of all arrivals (10,307) compared to the previous month of April 2017 (7,031)
- An increase of 36.9% of all air visitors (5,256) compared to April 2017 (3,840)
- An increase of 21.6% (3,470) of returning residents compared to previous month (2,853)
- An increase of 335.2% of arrivals by cruise ships compared to April 2017 (315)
- An increase of 813.0 % of arrivals by yachts compared to April 2017 (23).
- An increase of 36.2% of all departures from April 2017.



- Total air arrivals in May 2017 were 8,726 an increase of 3.1% compared to May 2016 (8,462).
- Total air departures of 7,599 in May 2017, again an increase of 7.0% compared to May 2016 (7,104)





• Total air visitor arrivals in May 2017 were 5,256 an increase of 0.7% compared to May 2016 (5,220)

Fig. 3: Air Visitors by Purpose of Visit May, 2017




Fig. 4: Air visitors by Country of Usual Residence May, 2017





Fig. 5: Air Departures by Country of Usual Residence May, 2017



- 44.6% (2,343) of the total air visitors were here to visit relatives/friends
- Holiday/Vacations made up 29.1%
 (1,529) of all air visitors to the Kingdom in the month of May
- Visitors who were here on Business or Conference made up 16.7% (876) and those with other reasons were 9.4% (494)
- New Zealand remains as the leading country in visitors arrivals by country of usual residence, accounting for 50.2% (2,637) of total air visitors
- This was followed by Australia with 21.6 % (1,134), and USA 13.8% (725)

 Most of the persons departing in the month of May were residents of Tonga (2,835) followed by New Zealand (2,460) and Australia (972)

Background Information

Data is extracted from the arrival and departure cards of the Immigration Department, Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Customs vessel & yacht log book. The Statistics Department reconciles the figures from the Air Terminal Services Manifest, Tonga Airport Limited and Ports Authority Manifest to produce final published data.

Statistics on Overseas Arrivals and Departures related to the number of movements of travelers rather than the number of travelers (i.e. the multiple movements of individual persons during a given reference period are all counted).

Definitions

- ▶ A Visitor is a person other than a Tongan citizen, permit holder and exempted person, who usually stay at least 24 hours in the Kingdom, or who stays overnight in accommodation within Tonga. This refers to passengers arriving by air and yacht only.
- ▶ Cruise Ship Passengers are defined as those who arrive and depart in the same vessel which is on a cruise trip, and use that vessel's accommodation during their stay in Tonga. They are also known as "Excursionist"
- ▶ A Returning resident is a person who has the Kingdom of Tonga as their permanent address for more than six months of the year and returns to Tonga after a trip overseas. Tongan residence is self-defined as reported by travelers when completing the Passenger Arrival Card.
- ▶ **Mode of Transport** Only air, yacht and cruise ships passengers are included. Passenger/crew on cargo, navy or special vessels are excluded.

The Statistics Department wishes to acknowledge the cooperation of the Immigration Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Trade and the Custom Department of the Ministry of Revenue Services, Air Terminal Services, Ports Authority making it possible to publish these important statistics.
