CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR FEBRUARY 2012

(Base Period : October 2010=100.0)

Consumer Price Index for February 2012 increased by 0.5%. **With an Annual Inflation Rate of 2.6%**

The Consumer Price Index covers price changes in Tongatapu Division only. The weights were derived from Household Income and Expenditure Survey of 2009

1. The **Consumer Price Index (CPI)** for February 2012 **recorded an increase of 0.5%** over January 2012 (103.6) and now stands at 104.1. When comparing the Local and Imported indexes during February 2012 to the previous month, Local Index increased by 1.0% and Imported Index increased by 0.1%.
2. For the previous two months, December 2011 decreased by 0.2% and recorded no change, 0.0% in January 2012.
3. The **Annual Rate of Inflation** for February 2012 was **2.6%**. The Local Index recorded an Annual Inflation Rate of 1.0% while the Imported Index was 3.7%. The annual inflation for the same month of previous year, February 2011 was **6.5%**.
4. Changes in each group compared with the previous month are as follows:

A.	FOOD	0.9%
	The Food Group marked a price increase of 0.9%. Local fruits & vegetables such as tomatoes, carrots, head cabbage and capsicum cause the rapid increases in Food Group from a decrease of 0.1% in January 2012. Imported meat also marked an increase in items like beef, mutton flaps and lamp chop. In contrast, prices of cereals and cereals products decreased by 0.9% during the period.	
B.	HOUSING	0.3%
	Housing Groups recorded a price increase of 0.3% towards the index position of February 2012. This was due mainly to increase in prices recorded for imported house maintenance goods such as paint.	
C.	HOUSEHOLD OPERATIONS	0.0%
	Prices of items in this group recorded no change this month compared to previous month.	
D.	CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR	0.0%
	Prices of items in this group recorded no change this month compared to previous month.	
E.	TRANSPORTATION	0.8%
	Transportation Group marked a price increase of 0.8% towards the index position of February 2012. This was due mainly to increase in price recorded for petrol, both diesel and unleaded compared to January 2012.	
F.	TOBACCO, ALCOHOL & KAVA TONGA	0.1%
	Tobacco, Alcohol and Kava Tonga Groups item recorded a price increase of 0.1% this month compared to January 2012 due to increase in price of tobacco.	
G.	MISC. GOODS AND SERVICES	-0.1%
	Prices of items in this group recorded a decrease of 0.1% due mainly to decrease in prices of cosmetics and toiletries like deodorant.

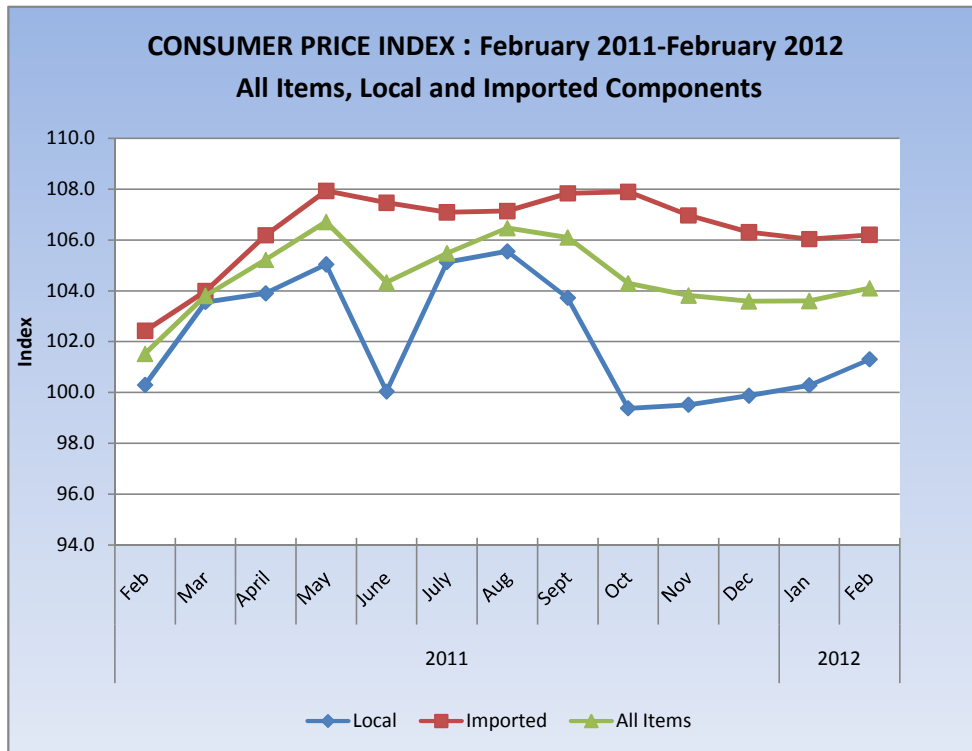


Fig 1: Graphical representation of Consumer Price Index for Total, Local and Imported Components

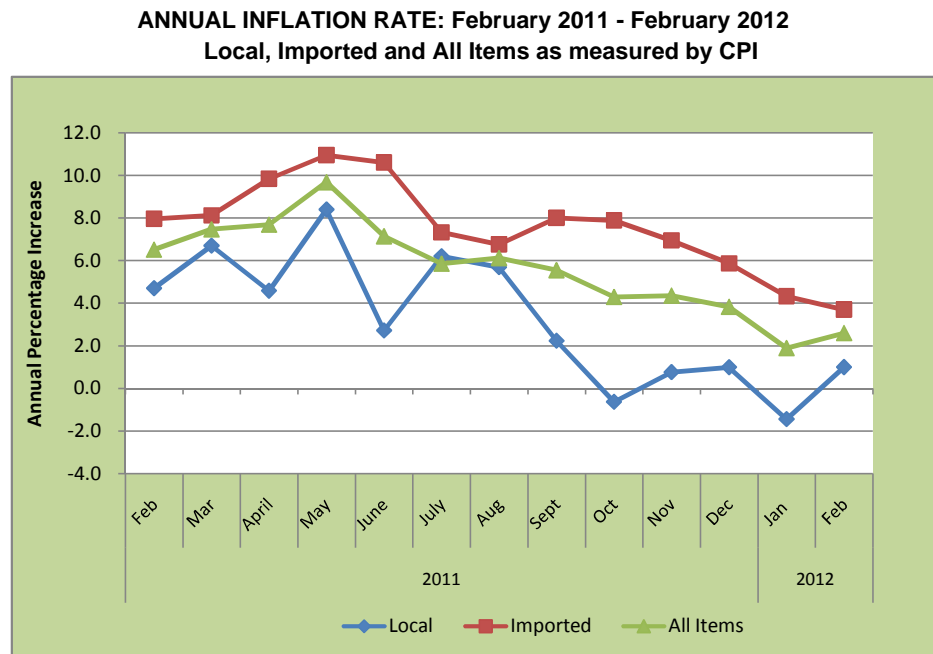


Fig 2: Graphical representation of Annual Inflation rate (%) for Local, Imported and All Items as measured by Consumer Price Index (CPI)

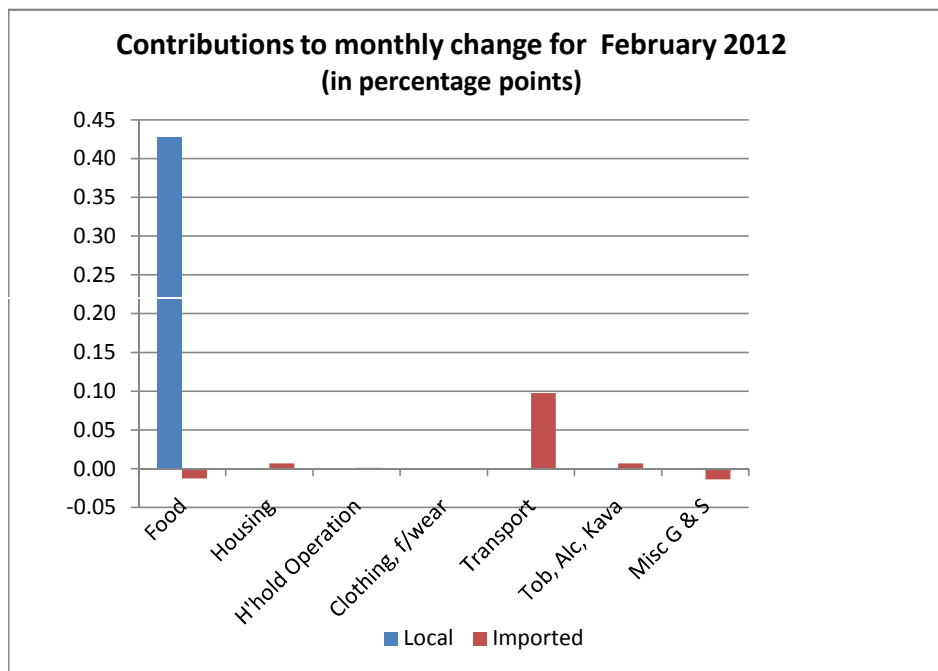
