CONSUMER PRICE INDEX FOR MAY 2013

(Base Period: October 2010=100.0)

Consumer Price Index for May 2013 decreased by 0.2%.
With an Annual Inflation Rate of -0.1%.

The Consumer Price Index covers price changes in the Tongatapu Division only. The weights were derived from the Household Income and Expenditure Survey (2009).

1. The **Consumer Price Index (CPI)** for May 2013 recorded a decrease by **0.2% to 107.0** from April 2013 **107.1**. Over the previous two months, the index for all items increased by **0.7%** in April 2013, and increased by **1.1%** in March 2013.
2. When comparing the local and imported indices for May 2013 to the previous month, import index decreased by **-0.7%**, and local index increased by **0.6%**.
3. The **annual rate of inflation** for May 2013 was **-0.1%** (Deflation) compared to **0.5%** inflation in the previous month. This is the first Deflation since September 2012 (**-0.8%**). The annual inflation for the same month of previous year (May 2012) was **0.4%**.
4. When comparing the annual change in the local and imported indices for May 2013, the local index does not change while the imported index decreased of **0.2%**.
5. Changes in each group compared with the previous month are as follows:

A.	FOOD	-0.4%
	Food Group recorded a decrease towards the index position of May 2013. This was due to decrease in prices of local fruits and vegetables such as capsicum, head cabbage, tomatoes and carrots. Meat, fish & Poultry products marked an increase due to increase in price of chicken pieces, mutton flap and local seafood items such as octopus, clam, and sea urchin. Dairy Farm & Vegetables products also recorded a decrease due to decrease in price of eggs.	
B.	HOUSING	0.0%
	Prices of items in this group recorded no change compared to previous months.	
C.	HOUSEHOLD OPERATIONS	1.5%
	Household Operation group marked an increase by 1.5% due to increased in price of Electricity.	
D.	CLOTHING AND FOOTWEAR	0.0%
	Prices of items in this group recorded no change this month compared to the previous month.	
E.	TRANSPORTATION	-2.2%
	Transportation index marked a decrease in the index position of May 2013 and was due mainly to decreases in prices of both diesel and unleaded.	
F.	TOBACCO, ALCOHOL & KAVA TONGA	0.0%
	Price of items in this group recorded no change this month compared to May 2013.	
G.	MISC. GOODS AND SERVICES	0.0%
	Price of items in this group recorded no change.	

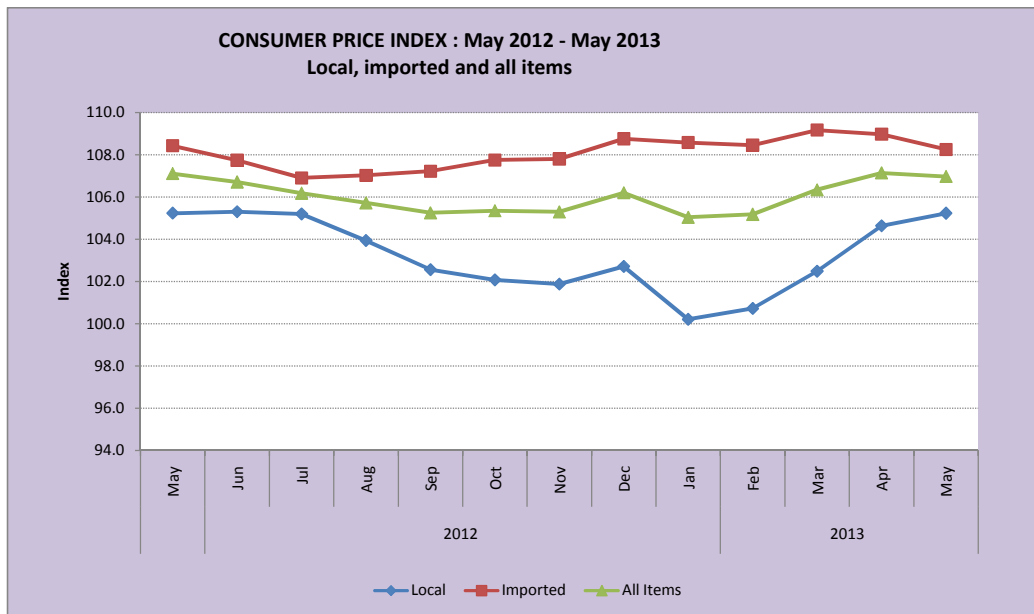


Fig 1: Graphical representation of Consumer Price Index for Total, Local and Imported Components

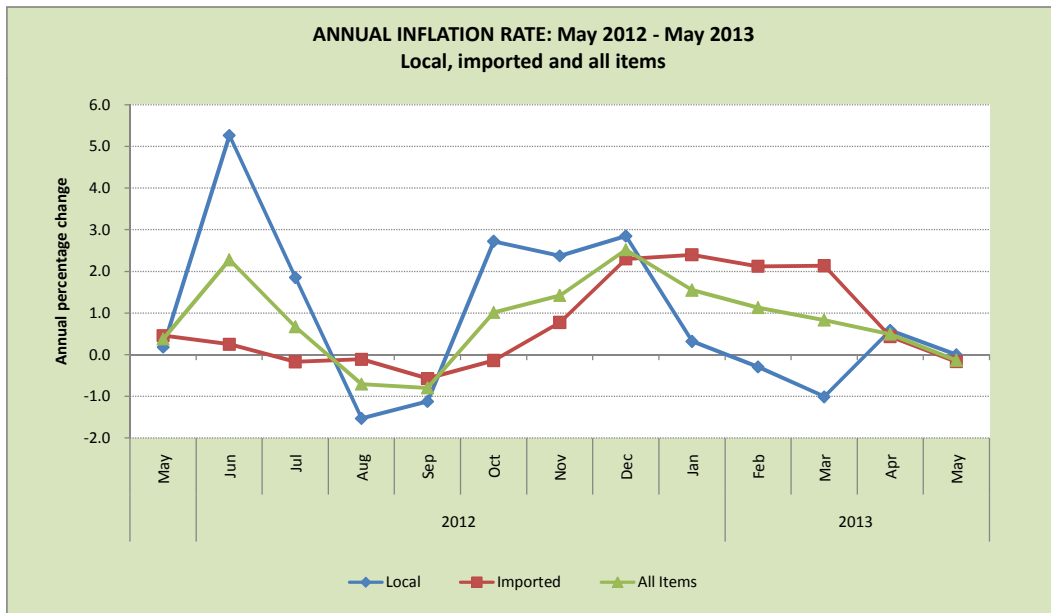
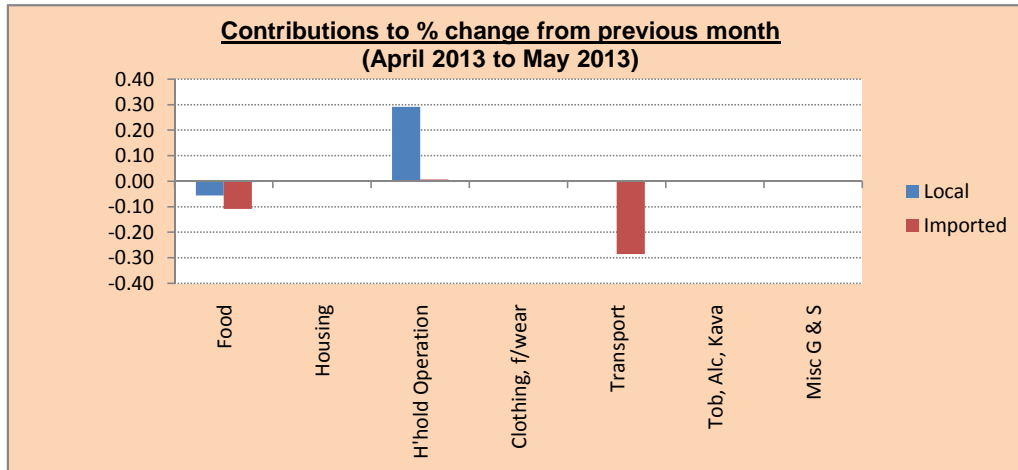


Fig 2: Graphical representation of Annual Inflation rate (%) for Local, Imported and All Items as measured

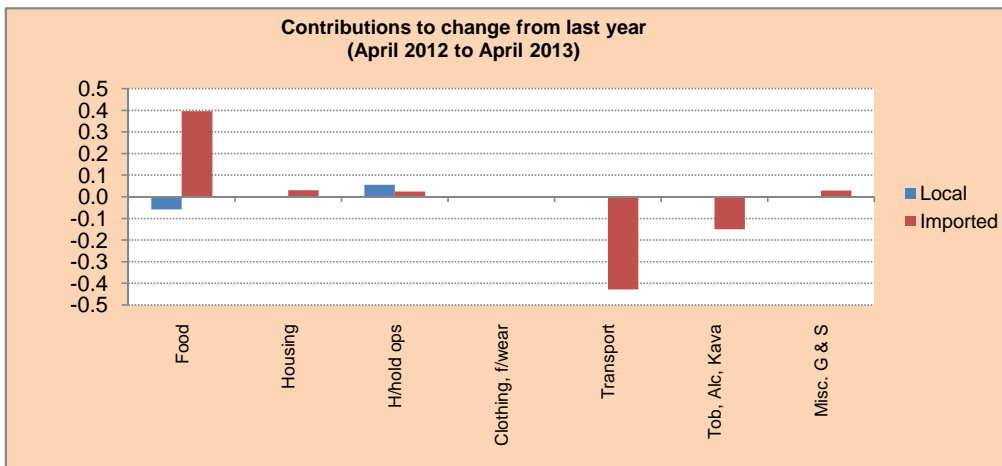
