


Consumer Price Index for July 2016 recorded an increase of 2.8% With an Annual Inflation Rate of 1.6%.



The Consumer Price Index (CPI) for July 2016 recorded an increase of 2.8% from June 2016 (108.9) and now stands at 112.0. In comparison with the previous month, local index recorded a decrease of 0.6% and import index increased by 5.6%. For the previous two months, June 2016 recorded an increase of 0.5% and May 2016 decreased by 0.2%.

The annual rate of inflation for July 2016 was 1.6% compares to 0.1% in previous month. The annual inflation for the same month of previous year, July 2015 was 1.6%. Local Index marked an increase by 1.6% and Imported Index increased by 1.7% in July 2016.

Food Group recorded an increase of **3.9**% towards the index position of **July 2016**. This was mainly due to increase in prices of some **fruits and vegetables** items. Prices of some imported items especially with mutton flap and chicken piece and other tinned & packaged food increased throughout the months.

Housing Group recorded a decrease by 0.2% towards the index position of **July 2016**. This was due to decrease in price of **timber** compares to the previous month.

Household Operation group recorded an increase of 0.9% towards the index position of **July 2016.** This was due to increase in price of **Electricity** compares to the previous month, although there was a decreased in price of **LP Gas**.

Tobacco, **alcohol & kava Tonga group** index marked a huge increase **by 6.1%** towards the index position of **July 2016**. This was due to increase in price of **Tobacco** compares to the previous month.

Clothing & footwear groups index recorded no change compares to the previous month.

Transportation group index recorded an increase by **3.3%** towards the index position of **July 2016**. This was due to increase in price of both **petrol** and **diesel** compares to the previous month.

Misc. Goods and Services group index recorded an increase of 0.3% due to increase in price of some cosmetics and toiletries items compared to the previous month.
